- WHEREAS** the requirement for proper road identification has increased since the implementation of the 911 system.
WHEREAS the signage needs to be properly placed and visible along Provincial highways for emergency services and the traveling public.
WHEREAS having separate posts results in visibility issues and more obstacles placed in municipal ditches.
WHEREAS it is the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure current policy to have the Township/Range Road signage placed on a separate post and set back outside of their right of way.
BE IT RESOLVED that SARM lobby the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure to review their sign policy to allow for placement of Township/Range Road Signs on existing posts that are in the highway right of way for 911 and road identification purposes.
