

BYLAW NO 253/17

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSOMIN NO.121 PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF CLUBROOT DISEASE OF CRUCIFERS BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moosomin No. 121 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be referenced as the “Clubroot Bylaw”
2. In this Bylaw:
 - a) “officer” means an officer within the meaning of *The Pest Control Act*;
 - b) “Municipality” means the Rural Municipality of Moosomin No. 121;
3. Unless otherwise specified, the owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of land situated in the Municipality shall be responsible for carrying out the provisions of this Bylaw.
4. Every owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of any land in the Municipality shall notify the Municipality in which the land is located of the presence of clubroot, within 30 days of becoming aware of the same and provide the exact location of the disease using the attached Form A. Completed Form A should be returned to the office of the Rural Municipality of Moosomin No. 121.
5. The Notification of Clubroot shall be in Form “A”, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.
6. Where the officer believes that a person has contravened any provision of this Bylaw, a Bylaw Violation Notice may be served either personally or by mailing or leaving same at the last known address.
7. The Bylaw Violation Notice shall be in Schedule “1”, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.
8. The Bylaw Violation Notice shall be deemed to have been served:
 - a) on the expiration of twenty- four hours after it is posted, if the notice is mailed;
 - b) on the day of actual delivery, if the notice is served personally; or
 - c) on the business day following the transmission, if given by facsimile.
9. In lieu of prosecution, the person who has contravened the provisions of this Bylaw shall pay a fine in the amount of \$ _____ which shall be indicated on the Bylaw Violation Notice.
