

**BYLAW NO. 273/19**

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSOMIN NO.121**

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH INFRASTRUCTURE FEES ON ALL PROPERTIES WITHIN  
DIVISION 7 OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSOMIN NO.121**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moosomin No. 121 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the “Infrastructure Fee Bylaw”.
2. In this bylaw:
  - a) “Property” shall mean any lot that has an assessed improvement on the lot.
  - b) “Infrastructure Fee” shall mean a quarterly charge added to the Water and Sewer quarterly invoices.
3. An Infrastructure Fee of \$60 per quarter (invoiced January, April, June and December) will be added to the Water and Sewer invoices payable within the first month of invoices.
4. Any portion of this fee remaining unpaid after 90 days shall be added to the tax roll.
5. The monies collected from this charge shall be used to cover the Water Treatment Plant loan until such time as all debt is paid.
6. Thereafter all monies will then be placed into a reserve account to cover future infrastructure costs to avoid unnecessary increases to the quarterly water and sewer invoices.
7. THIS bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2019.
